#### **General Information**

The Zonta Club of Oneida Area celebrates Zonta Rose Day annually in conjunction with International Women's Day by presenting a community achievement award. This award recognizes a woman whose endeavors best express the ideals of Zonta International through service and advocacy to advance the status of women.

#### What are the criteria?

- Nominee will have been involved in activities which <u>enhance the opportunities for women.</u>
- Nominee will have spearheaded or had a significant role in the development of <u>program(s) that</u> <u>benefit women</u> through volunteerism or in the workplace.
- The nominee will have contributed to raising social awareness of <u>women's issues</u> among peers and others. She will have impacted women by displaying leadership participation or originating projects which address community issues such as domestic violence, literacy, health, quality of living conditions, education, politics, journalism, peaceful understanding/goodwill, justice/equality in working conditions, etc.

#### How do I submit a nomination?

- Complete the nomination form.
- Include a typewritten history/profile of the woman you are nominating. This should detail accomplishments which are <u>relevant</u> to this award and why you feel this nominee should be the recipient.
