What are the criteria?

- Nominee will be involved in activities which enhance opportunities for women.
- Nominee will have spearheaded or had a significant role in the development of program(s) or project(s) that benefit women.
- The nominee will have contributed to raising social awareness of women's issues among peers and others. She will have impacted women by displaying leadership, participation or originating projects which address community issues such as domestic violence, literacy, health, quality of living conditions, education, politics, journalism, peaceful understanding/goodwill, justice/equality in working conditions, etc.

How do I submit a nomination?

- Include a typewritten history/profile of the woman you are nominating. This should detail accomplishments which are relevant to this award and why you feel this nominee should be the recipient.
